

**I. General**

To the Residents of the Borough of Haworth:

The 2011 Budget submitted herewith reflects the amount necessary for the support of the Municipal Operations.

Comparison of Tax Rates

At this time the Governing Body is unable to project with any accuracy the overall tax rate for the community. Both School and County tax requirements have not yet been finalized. The Mayor and Council has only the authority to approve the "Local Municipal Budget". The table below is a comparison of the prior year and projected 2011 municipal tax rate.

This year the Mayor and Council was confronted with a limit placed on Municipal expenditures and Tax Levy. A full explanation of the "CAP" and provisions and its calculation are set forth in section II and III and of the following pages.

II. Appropriations "CAP"

Chapter 68, Public Laws of 1976 and the 1990 revisions of Chapter 89, places limits on municipal expenditures commonly referred to as the "CAP", which is actually calculated by a method established by the Law.

The actual calculation is somewhat complex, but in general it works as follows: Starting with the 2010 Budget for Total General Appropriations, the following figures are deducted; Reserve for Uncollected Taxes, Debt Service, Capital Improvements, Other Operations Excluded from the "CAP", Emergency Authorizations and Public and Private Funded Programs. Multiply this figure by the cost of living adjustment ("COLA") this gives you the basic "CAP" or the increase in appropriations over the 2010 total general appropriations. For calendar year 2011, the COLA adjustment is two percent (2%)

In addition to the increase allowed above, other increases are allowed

- o increases funded by the added valuation from new construction and improvements
- o amounts approved by referendum.
- o amounts available from prior year "CAP" banks

The Governing Body is also permitted to increase its "CAP" by up to 1.5% if an index rate ordinance is adopted. This budget is based upon a 3.5% "CAP" increase.

**V. Municipal Library Tax Levy Law**

Pursuant to State Law (P.L. 2011, c.38) the minimum required appropriation for the Haworth Free Public Library will be a separate line item on your property tax bill. The municipal tax levy will be reduced by the same amount as the new library tax levy. This change does not result in a property tax increase and is to help you better understand the costs of library services reflected in your property tax bill.

The Governing Body will be ready to answer and discuss, at the public hearing any questions regarding items in this budget subject to its control and discretion.

On May 10, 2011 at 7:30 P.M., at the Municipal Center, Borough of Haworth, a hearing on the Municipal Budget will be held. The public has the right and is encouraged to provide oral and written comments, ask questions and otherwise participate in the budget adoption process.

Information on the 2011 Municipal Budget, together with a true copy of the entire proposed budget is available to the public for their inspection by contacting Ann E. Fay, at 300 Haworth Ave., Haworth, NJ 07641, (201) 384-4785.

It is the intent of the Governing Body to not only scrutinize every request for spending but to pursue (within its legal powers) prompt collection of revenue and to find, if possible, new sources of income.
