

Haworth Swim Club Rules & Regulations

IDENTIFICATION & ADMISSION

Pool use shall be restricted to club members in good standing and shall include each member's spouse, unmarried children residing at home, and individuals that have been appropriately issued membership cards.

Each member must surrender membership card to attendant when entering pool area. Members must also take home cards when they leave for the day. If a card is lost, notify the manager.

Membership cards are not transferable. Any member who transfers their membership card is subject to suspension.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Opening Day is the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend. The pool will be open weekends only 11:00am to 6:45 pm until June 19th. Beginning June 25th, the pool is open from 10 am to 7:45 pm until Labor Day.

Any variation of the above hours will be posted on the bulletin board at the club's entrance.

The pool will be closed when necessary for maintenance, and also, at the discretion of the Manager, during inclement weather. The pool and entire pool deck area are off limits for thirty minutes following the sound of thunder.

A portion of either pool may be reserved by the manager at any time for special activities such as swimming lessons, swim team or lap swimming.

GUESTS

A member must register their guests before entering the pool/or picnic area. Members are responsible for inappropriate action of their guests.

No part-time or full-time servant shall be considered as a family member. Au pair and Care-giver cards are available at an additional cost.

Use of the club's facility, such as the picnic area, by a non-member requires the non-member to be registered as a guest.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Pool Manager and lifeguards during pool hours are in full charge and are authorized to enforce all rules and regulations. Whenever additional rules are deemed advisable for the proper conduct of the pools and protection of its patrons, the management is authorized to issue and put into effect such rules either printed or verbal.

All bathers must wear proper attire. No cut off shorts allowed.

No running, wrestling, pushing or causing undue disturbance or hazard in or about the pool area.

No pets allowed on club property.

Admission may be refused to anyone with skin abrasions, open wounds, colds, inflamed eyes infection or wearing bandages. Upon competent medical advice, certain exception may be permitted.

Expectorating or blowing of nose in pool is prohibited.

Floation devices in the pools, such as life jackets, inflated tubs, water wings toys, etc, are prohibited. Water masks and snorkels are also prohibited.

Hanging on to lane lines or rope dividers is prohibited.

Use of the kiddie pool shall be limited to children under 10 years of age.

Parents are required to keep children who are not toilet-trained out of the large pools.

The club reserves the right to limit swimming by children to avoid over-fatigue.

No smoking is allowed on pool deck or in the restrooms.

The pool area must be cleared during a thunderstorm, until management deems it safe.

No alcoholic beverages of any kind may be brought into the pool area during regular pool hours.

No food or refreshments (except water) allowed at any time in the pool area. They may be consumed only in the designated area.

No glass containers of any kind allowed in pool area.

The club will not be responsible for loss of or damage to personal property. All persons shall use the pool and its facilities at their own risk. The club will not be responsible for any accident or injury in connection with such use.

Members shall be charged with the cost of any property damages caused by any member of the family or their guests. It is to be remembered that lifeguards are not to be used as "babysitters" and cannot be made responsible for children in the absence of their parents.

Radios must be played at a reasonable volume designated by the management.

Diving from the pool's edge is only allowed in the diving area. Please observe no diving signs on the pool's deck. No swimming in the diving area or bounding on the diving boards

For purpose of restricted swimming periods (adult swim) adults are 18 or older. Only toilet-trained children 6 and under are permitted to swim with an adult at this time.

Use of the pool/facilities is subject to restrictions and directions by management.

SWIMMING & POOL RULES

Swimmers are only permitted one bounce on the diving board.

Starting blocks are off limits except during swim team or swim lessons.

Swimmers must use the ladders or stairs to exit the pool.

Swimmers must wait for the diving well to be clear before using the slide or diving board.

Swimmers must go down the slide on their backside feet first.

Swimmers are not permitted to hang or sit on the diving board.

Water launching devices (i.e. water-guns) are not permitted in the pool or pool area. Balls and toys are permitted, but HSC Staff reserves the right to remove toys due to excessive play or crowds.

PICNIC AREA & GROUNDS

Permission for use of the grounds and picnic area must be secured from pool manager. Parties are approved based on availability of tables. Tables must be reserved at front desk.

Please put all recyclable materials in receptacles labeled for recycling.

Members shall drive slowly and carefully on driveways and in parking area. They shall not exceed a speed of 10 miles per hour. All bicycles and moped riders shall use designated area and shall ride carefully.
