I am informed by the clerk that adequate public notice has been provided by posting a notice on the bulletin board in the Municipal Center, and by mailing notice to all persons who requested same and prepaid the cost fixed by the Council."

OLD BUSINESS

Pam Zipse, a Certified Tree Expert, has advised us that preparing the Five-Year Management Plan will cost \$4,000.

An "Accomplishment Report" should be submitted, and the Forest Management Plan approved by December 31, 2015.

We have accepted Arrow's bid of \$21,000 for the Winter Tree Program.

Borough tree work was done at the Swim Club.

NEW BUSINESS

For the Arbor Day ceremony at the school, Ben will contact the appropriate assistant principal.

Glenn suggested a Borough-wide emailing inviting those interested in a shade tree for their easement to contact us.

We will look for easements that are in need of shade trees and notify residents of our intention to plant a tree.

Jack said that ten trees in our Tree Farm are ready to be planted.

Thirty whips (sprigs, usually several feet tall) will soon arrive, to be planted at the Farm.

The meeting adjourned at 8:40 p.m. The next meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 5, 2015, at 7: 25 p.m.
