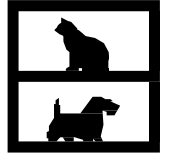

2025 DOG & CAT LICENSE APPLICATION – DUE BY JAN. 31, 2025

IMPORTANT – If you obtained a dog/cat license last year

There will be a separate mailing with your pet's information and an invoice. Please check the information is correct, including the rabies expiration date. Make a note of any changes and return to the Clerk's Office with your check and self-addressed, stamped envelope. The license will be sent to you upon our receipt.

- _____ 1. Return this application form completely filled out.
- _____ 2. Provide a copy of rabies vaccination certificate. **Must be valid through Nov.1st.**
- _____ 3. Provide proof of spay/neuter if not provided on the rabies vaccination certificate.
- _____ 4. Check or money order payable to the "Borough of Haworth" with correct fee.
- _____ 5. If applying by mail, please include a stamped self-addressed envelope.

FEES: Dogs Spayed/Neutered \$13.00 Cats: Spayed/Neutered \$10.00
Unneutered Dogs & Cats \$16.00

LATE FEES: Begin February 1st. \$5.00 per month, per cat/dog.

LICENSE WILL NOT BE ISSUED WITHOUT THE NEUTERING AND RABIES VACCINATION INFORMATION

1. Local Ordinance (CH.5 Animal Control) requires licenses for dogs and cats. New dogs/cats must be licensed within 10 days of acquisition. Any dog/cat brought into the borough for more than 10 days must be licensed in the borough (except if licensed in another state in which case you must obtain a license if they live in the borough more than 90 days). This includes fosters.
2. All dog and cat licenses expire on January 31 of each year and must be renewed during the month of January.
3. All dogs and cats must be licensed – Even if your pet never leaves the house.
4. Check rabies and neuter status. If this is a new registration or there have been any changes since the last registration, be sure to enclose required veterinarian certificates which will be returned.
5. **If your vet cites a medical reason why your pet cannot get a rabies vaccine, you and your vet must complete and submit form VPH-28 (available from our office or <https://www.nj.gov/health/forms/vph-28.pdf>). Must update every year.**
6. License form and tag will be issued/mailed upon receipt of this form & payment payable to the "Borough of Haworth".

PET LICENSING

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 8:23A-4.2, the State requires that dogs with rabies vaccinations expiring before November 1st of the licensing year **MUST be revaccinated before we can issue a license or renewal license.** Pet owners must provide a rabies vaccination certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian indicating that the animal's duration of immunity extends throughout at least the first ten months of the twelve-month licensing period. Animals that have a duration of immunity which expires prior to the ten-month cut-off must receive a booster rabies vaccination prior to licensure. § 5-8.7 Leashing of Dogs.

[1984 Code § 9-8.6] No person owning, keeping or harboring any dog shall suffer or permit it to be upon the public streets or in any of the public places of the Borough unless such dog is accompanied by a person over the age of 12 years and is securely confined and controlled by an adequate leash not more than eight feet long.
