

## When do I have to license my cat or dog?

Dog and cat licenses are to be renewed every January. If you adopt a dog or cat during the year, you should obtain a license as soon as possible. If it is a puppy or kitten, you cannot get a license until they have gotten their first rabies vaccination.

## How often must licenses be renewed? fees?

Licenses are renewed annually. The fees are:

Neutered dogs - \$11.00

Unneutered dogs - \$14.00

Cats - \$8.00

## How do I license my cat or dog or renew a pet license?

To obtain a pet license for the first time, there is a form on line you can complete and mail in with a check made payable to "Borough of Haworth", proof of rabies vaccination and proof of sterilization.

To renew a pet's license, due in January, you will be receiving an invoice in the mail. Check over the information on the invoice, make any changes, and return with your check.

## Who do I call if I see a dead deer in the street?

Any dead animal in the street should be reported to the Department of Public Works by calling 201-384-1037.

If you see an animal you suspect is sick, you should call the Bergen County Animal Shelter at 201-229-4600.
