- A resident was bitten by a raccoon on Pine Lane and they had to go for rabies shots.
- A called was received from the Borough Hall asking that the Clark residence on Valley Road be inspected. ProChem was called.

COUNCIL REPORT

Councilwoman Guenego reported on the following:

- The Governing Body has considered revising an existing ordinance which bans the use of single-use plastics. She went over their proposal and exceptions.
- The Downtown Renovation Project started in July and they anticipate that street construction will finish by the end of September. She went over the progress of different aspects of the renovation.

- Haworth Day will be held on October 5th.

Fliers will be posted with additional information.


ADMINISTRATIVE
