

Haworth Approved Tree List (March 2025)

Jersey Natives= JN Jersey Friendly= JF

At this time, the Shade Tree Commission recommends planting trees of the Maple genus sparingly in order to increase the diversity of trees in Haworth.

Medium to Large Trees (over 25')

Common name/ Scientific Name

Black Maple/ *Acer Nigrum* 60-75' JN

Red maple/ *Acer rubrum**shallow roots. Avoid planting near pavement 35-80' JN

Sugar Maple/ *Acer saccharum* 60-75' JN *intolerant of road salt

Yellow Buckeye/ *Aesculus flava* 60-75' JN *fruit/ twig litter

Yellow Birch/ *Betula alleghaniensis* 60-75' JN *long lived for birch 100yrs. +

Sweet Birch/ *Betula lenta* 50-75' JN

River Birch/ *Betula nigra* 40-70' JN

European Hornbeam/ *Carpinus betulus* 40-60' JF

Bitternut Hickory/ *Carya cordiformis* 50-75' JN

Pignut Hickory/ *Carya glabra* 50-80' JN

Shagbark Hickory/ *Carya ovata* 60-80' JN

Common Hackberry/ *Celtis occidentalis* 40-60' JN *berry litter: Avoid planting near walkways

American Beech/ *Fagus grandifolia* 50-80' JN

Butternut/ *Juglans cinerea* 40-60' JN *roots produce juglones, toxic to some other plants

Black Walnut/ *Juglans nigra* 50-100' JN *juglones

Sweetgum/ *Liquidambar styraciflua* 40-60' JN *intolerant of alkaline soil and shade

Tuliptree/ *Liriodendron tulipifera* 70-90' JN

Cucumber-tree/ *Magnolia acuminata* 50-80' JN

Southern Magnolia/ *Magnolia grandiflora* 60-80' JF

Blackgum/ *Nyssa sylvatica* 30-50' JN

Hophornbeam/ *Ostrya virginiana* 25-40' JN

American Sycamore/ *Platanus occidentalis* 75-100' JN

Eastern Cottonwood/ *Populus deltoides* 75-100' JN * Good along streams Quaking

Aspen/ *Populus tremuloides* 40-50' JN

Black Cherry/ *Prunus serotina* 50-60' JN
Yoshino Cherry/ *Prunus x yedoensis* 35-45' JF
White Oak/ *Quercus alba* 50-80' JN
Swamp White Oak/*Quercus bicolor* 50-60 JN
Scarlet Oak/ *Quercus coccinea* 70-75' JN
Chestnut oak/ *Quercus montana* 60-70' JN
Pin Oak/ *Quercus palustris* 60-70' JN
Red Oak/ *Quercus rubra* 60-75' JN
Post Oak/ *Quercus stellata* 40-50' JN
Black Oak/ *Quercus velutina* 50-60' JN
Black Willow/ *Salix nigra* 30-60' JN *moist/wet soil. Good near stream banks
Sassafras/ *Sassafras albidum* 30-60' JN
American Basswood/ *Tilia americana* 60-80' JN
Littleleaf Linden/ *Tilia cordata* 60-70' JF
Silver Linden/ *Tilia tomentosa* 50-70' JF

Smaller Trees (Those over 25' may need pruning near wires)

Striped Maple/ *Acer pensylvanicum* 15-20' JN
Common Serviceberry (Shadbush)/ *Amelanchier arborea* 15-25' JN Allegheny
Serviceberry/ *Amelanchier laevis* 14-40' JN
Ironwood (American Hornbeam) 20-30' JN
Eastern Redbud/ *Cercis canadensis* 20-30' JN
Flowering dogwood/ *Cornus florida* 20-40' JN
Star Magnolia/ *Magnolia stellata* 15-20' JF
Sweetbay Magnolia/ *Magnolia virginiana* 10-20' JN
Saucer Magnolia/ *Magnolia x soulangiana* 20-30' JF
Sourwood/ *Oxydendrum arboretum* 25-30' JF
American Plum/ *Prunus americana* 15-25' JN
Common Hoptree/ *Ptelea trifoliata* 15-20' JN
Scrub Oak/ *Quercus ilicifolia* 15-20' JN
Japanese Lilac/ *Syringa reticulata* 20-30' JF
Chokecherry/ *Prunus Virginiana* 20-30' JN
Southern Crabapple/ *Malus angustifolia* JN
Sweet Crabapple/ *Malus coronaria* JN
Prairie Crabapple/ *Malus ioensis* JN
Fringe Tree/ *Chionanthus virginicus* JN
Cockspur Hawthorn/ *Crataegus crus-galli*
