COUNCIL REPORT

Councilwoman Guenego reported the following:

- The 2018 Budget was passed.
- A HVAC has been placed in the Library and training will be made available.
- Sunset Avenue will be repaved and people will have to take another route.
- The Borough has upgraded the phone system and email services.
- The Downtown Renovation bids came in too high and because this is the second time around, they will be able to negotiate. The Governing Body has been having discussion relating to angle parking, fixing the sidewalks and upgrading the lighting.

They have applied for matching funds for a grant to put in a walking train along the duck pond.

BITE BACK SEMINAR


Dr. Eigen talked about the Bergen County Department of Health Bite Back seminar, which she attended. She said it was interesting but poorly attended.
