ORDINANCE NO. 15-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER IX OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF HAWORTH ENTITLED "PARKS, PLAYGROUNDS AND RECREATIONAL AREAS"

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Haworth as follows:

Section 1 – Subsection 9-8.1, a. through g. entitled "Membership Fees for the Haworth Swim Club for 2014" shall be deleted and replaced with the following "Membership Fees for the Haworth Swim Club":

| e. Au Pair | \$150.00 |
| f. Late Fee after the Saturday of Memorial Day Week-end | \$50.00 |
| g. Guest Fees | \$10.00 |
| (Children Under Age 2 – No Charge) | |
| h. Replacement of Lost Cards | \$10.00 |

Section 2. – Inconsistent Ordinances. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies only.

Section 3. – Effect of partial Invalidity. If any provisions of this ordinance are found to be invalid, for any reason, by the final judgment of a Court of competent jurisdiction, the validity of such portions shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance, which shall be severable therefrom.

Section 4. – Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after final adoption and publication as required by law.
